

Course Syllabus Intaglio 101

This course is an introduction to intaglio techniques. It is intended for beginners who want to learn techniques of intaglio. It is an introduction to the use of the line and tone in printmaking. We will cover the three basic techniques: drypoint, etching and aquatint. In this course we will go through the history of printmaking, the works of great masters as well as the work of contemporary printmakers.

Objectives

The purpose of this course is to prepare the participant to be fluent in the use of the line and tone in the three main intaglio techniques mentioned above. Participants will have a chance to work in different materials as a matrix including plexiglass, aluminum, copper, brass and zinc. Participants will understand how to use the intaglio line and tone for the later development of their projects in printmaking.

This course is divided in two parts:

- 1. Theory: covers philosophy of the artworks as a multiple, as well as the works of master printmakers.
- 2. Practice: projects you will produce and present.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of the course the student will be able to:

- 1. Understand the history of printmaking
- 2. Understand the line and tone in printmaking
- **3. Explore** intaglio as a form of representation
- 4. **Explore** the different materials that can be used as a matrix
- 5. Understand the light metering, exposure and its variables
- 6. **Define** terms and theory in intaglio processes
- 7. Explore philosophy and reading the printed image through the works of master printmakers
